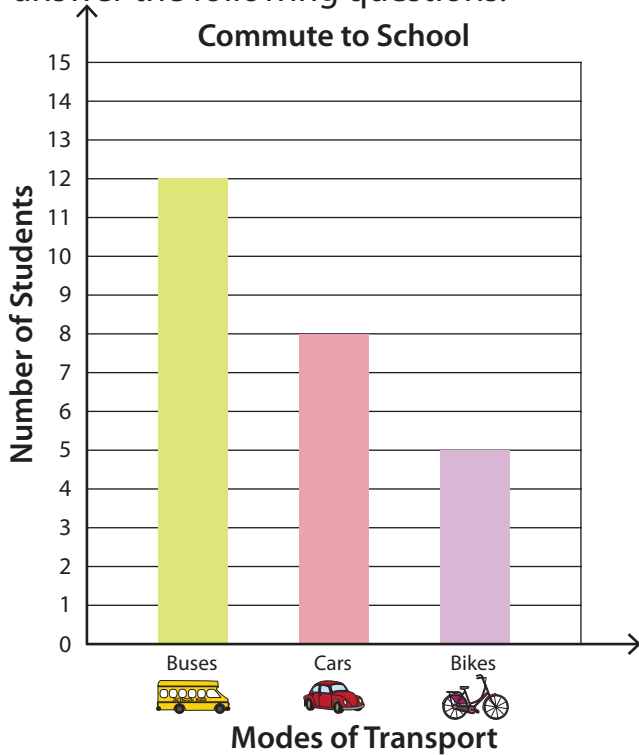





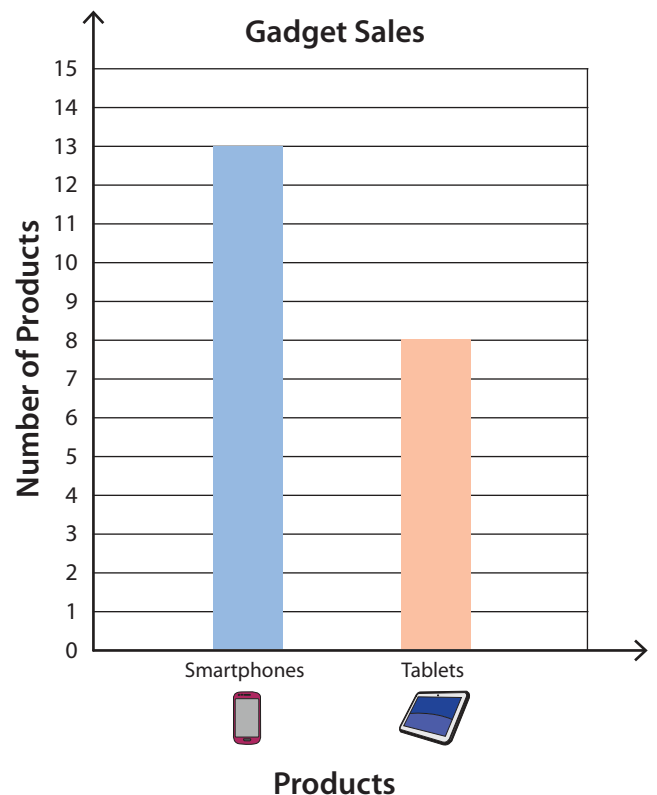
Reading and Interpreting Bar Graphs
