Mean = 8.3

Mean = 10.92

Mean = 8.1

4) 5.8, 17.7, 20, 3.4, 7.2, 17

Mean = 11.85

5) 4.8, 10.4, 19.1, 6.6, 9

Mean = 9.98

6) 9.3, 11.6, 2.5, 16.4

Mean = 9.95

7) 6.2, 0, 13.7, 1.6, 17, 4.1

Mean = 7.1

8) 18.6, 3, 8.4

Mean = 10
