38 cents

- 2) Mr. Shelby spends 3 quarters on a candy bar. If he buys a single piece of chewing gum for 2 dimes, how much does he spend altogether?

95 cents

- 3) A 40-year-old man parked his car in a suburban area and inserted 2 quarters and 5 nickels into the parking meter. How much did it cost to park the car?

75 cents

- 4) Melinda, a sales associate, returned 2 dimes and 6 nickels to Nicole. What change did Nicole receive in total?

50 cents

- 5) Rick saves 1 dime, 3 nickels, and 9 pennies in his coin jar every day. How much money does he save each day?

34 cents
